The 25th Anniversary MONTEREY RIDE

September 24-25, 2011

The Oakland Yellowjackets Bicycling Club would like to invite our members to join us for our annual Monterey Ride. This is not a race but a ride for cyclist of moderate to advance riding abilities.

ROUTES:

1. The 120 mile ride starts in Pacifica, ride across Devil's Slide, along the scenic coastline to Santa Cruz where lunch awaits you, continuing on Highway 1 ending in Pacific Grove, where you will be met with cheers and applause as you finish the ride. Sag support will be available if needed.
2. The 87 mile ride starts in scenic Pescadero, ride to Santa Cruz where lunch awaits you, continuing on Highway 1 ending in Pacific Grove. Sag support will be available if needed.

LOCATION

Ride starts from Pacifica at the Pacific Manor Parking Lot at 7:00am prompt. People in need of transportation to Pacifica, meet at Fairyland entrance at Lake Merritt 5:15am. All Pescadero riders will be transported from Pacifica to Pescadero, leaving at 7:00am. *Note: There is no overnight parking at the Lake Merritt or Pescadero.*

Directions to Lake:

FROM I-80 (westbound): Take 27th/West Grand exit, left at light, left on W.Grand, right at light (Bellevue) entrance to parking lot.

FROM I-580 (westbound): Take Lake Shore exit, left on Grand, left on Bellevue entrance to Fairyland parking lot.

Directions to Pacifica: Take I-80 across the Bay Bridge to San Francisco. I-101 South to I-280 South. I-280 South to Hwy 1 South. Hwy 1 to Pacifica, exit at Palmatto St. Meet at Pacific Manor shopping center parking lot.

WHEN CONSIDERING THIS RIDE REMEMBER!

- We obey all "Rules of the Road" as printed in the California Vehicle Code Laws.
- We obey all signal lights and stop at all stop signs. IF YOU FAIL TO DO SO, YOU MAY BE TICKETED.
- We share the road with car drivers and leave their share clear for safe driving.
- We ride close to the right edge of the road.
- We ride single file, particularly when traffic is present.
- We signal our turns and point out road hazard to other cyclists.

ACCIDENT WAIVER AND RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I acknowledge that this athletic event is an extreme test of a person's physical and mental limits and carries with it the potential for death, serious injury and property loss. The risks include, but are not limited to, those caused by terrain, facilities, temperature, weather, condition of athletes, equipment, vehicular traffic, actions of other people including, but not limited to, participants, volunteers, spectators, coaches, event officials, and event monitors, and/or producers of the event, and lack of hydration. These risks are not only inherent to athletics, but are also present for volunteers. I hereby assume all of the risks of participating &/or volunteering in this event. I realize that liability may arise from negligence or carelessness on the part of the persons or entities being released, from dangerous or defective equipment or property owned, maintained or controlled by them or because of their possible liability without fault.

I certify that I am physically fit, have sufficiently trained for participation in the event and have not been advised otherwise by a qualified medical person.

I acknowledge that this Accident Waiver and Release of Liability (AWRL) form will be used by the event holders, sponsors and organizers, in which I may participate and that it will govern my actions and responsibilities at said events.
